### **Buckeye Detectives Narrow Search for Vehicle Involved in Death of 16-Year-Old**

Buckeye police detectives have worked tirelessly for the past year on the death investigation of 16-year-old Anaiyah Walker. Her body was found by a passerby in the median of Interstate 10 near Watson Road on May 22, 2020.

The medical examiner ruled Walker's cause of death to be "high-velocity impact." Extensive forensic examinations have helped detectives narrow the vehicle believed to have made contact with Walker.

#### **VEHICLE:**

Years: 2016, 2017, 2018  
Make: Honda  
Model: Civic EX or LX  
Color: Midnight Burgundy Pearl

Vehicle parts found at the scene contain evidence of involvement with Walker. A number of parts are unique to the vehicle. The attached crime bulletin lists a few of the unique parts which may have been purchased to repair damage to the car.

1. Driver's side door mirror cover
2. Left front portion of front bumper
3. Left front fog light cover

**SYNOPSIS:** The body of Anaiah Walker was found by a passerby in the median of Interstate 10 near Watson Road. The medical examiner determined the cause of death to be high-velocity impact.

Extensive forensic examination has determined the car parts found at the scene belong to the listed vehicle. Replacement parts listed would have been obtained to repair the car.

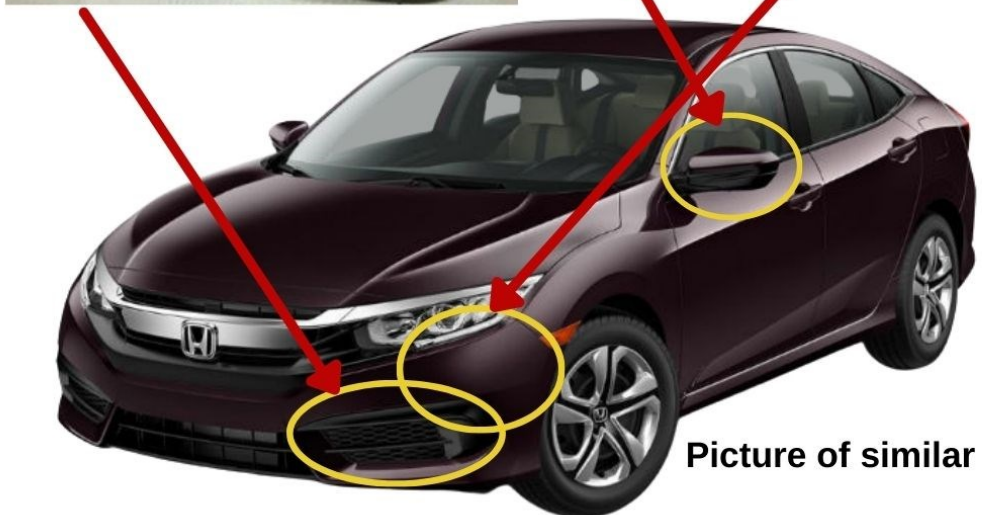
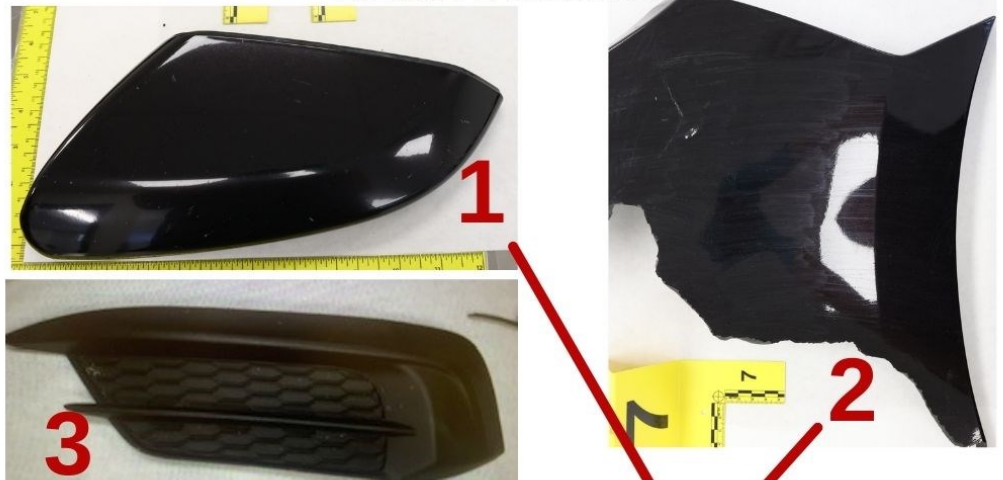
