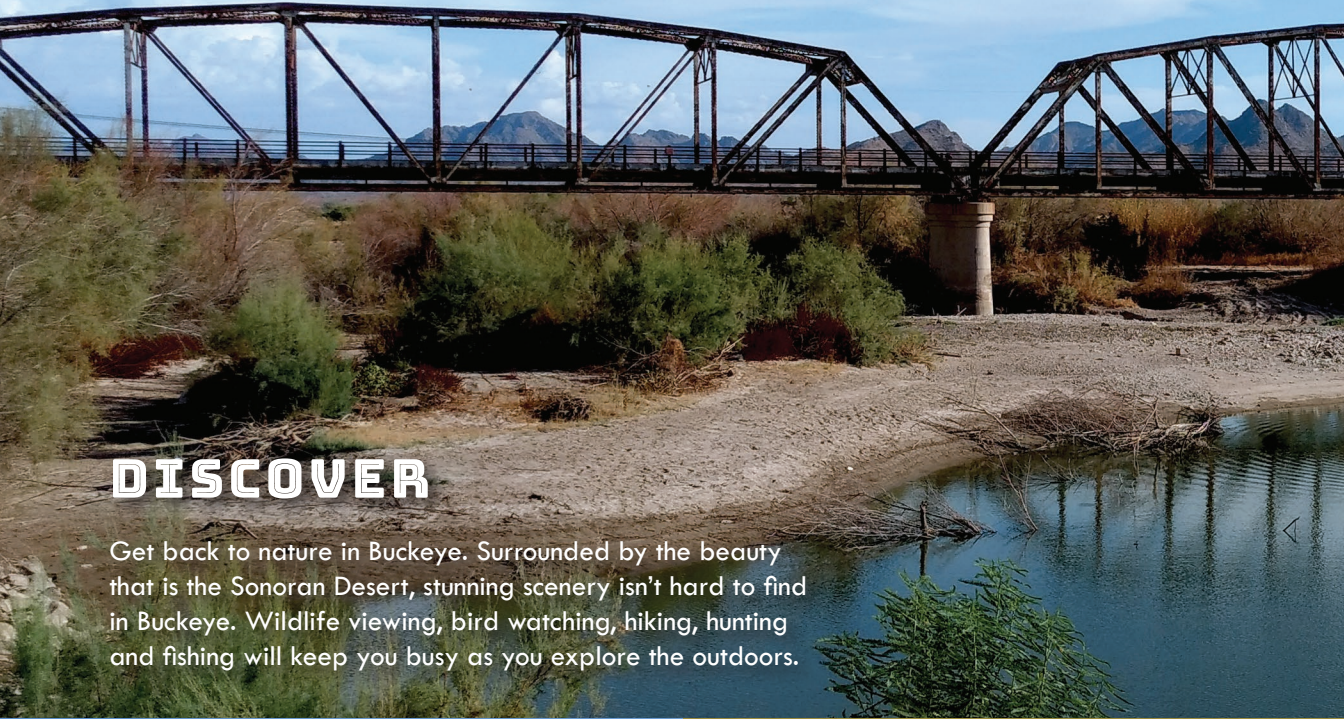

DISCOVER

Get back to nature in Buckeye. Surrounded by the beauty that is the Sonoran Desert, stunning scenery isn't hard to find in Buckeye. Wildlife viewing, bird watching, hiking, hunting and fishing will keep you busy as you explore the outdoors.



Gillespie Dam Bridge

The historic 1927 truss **Gillespie Dam Bridge** spans the Gila River and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The interpretive center gives insight to Arizona's transportation history.

Buckeye Hills Regional Park offers scenic rolling hills near the Gila River where you can camp, hike or picnic.

Located in the park, the **Joe Foss Shooting Complex** features a 200 yard rifle and pistol range to help get you sighted in. The complex also includes a trap and skeet field along with an archery range.

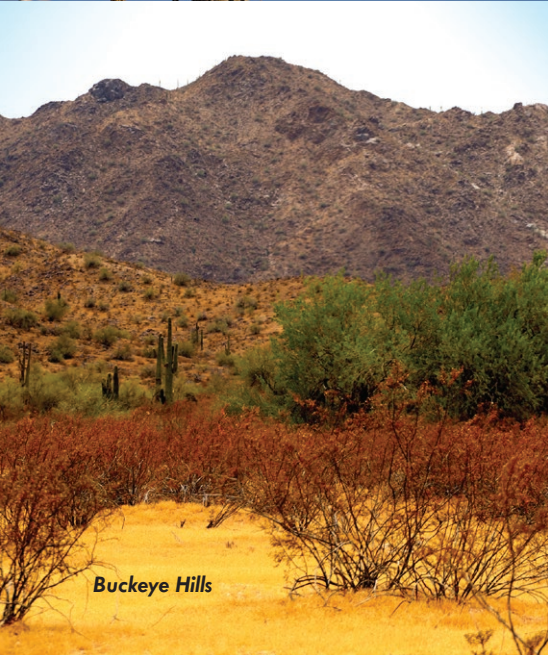


WILDLIFE AREAS

Powers Butte Wildlife Area spans 1,120 acres along the Gila River with abundant plant and wildlife. This area offers many opportunities for the outdoor enthusiast, including hiking, birdwatching, hunting and fishing.

Robbins Butte Wildlife Area is a 1,600 acre riparian habitat nestled along the Gila River that draws in large populations of wildlife. Native American ruins and petroglyphs paint a picture of the past as you take in the expansive views from atop Robbins Butte.

Arlington Wildlife Area stretches 1,500 acres along the Gila River and features two ponds which draw in numerous waterfowl and other birds. Wildlife viewing, hunting and hiking are a few of the opportunities at Arlington Wildlife Area.

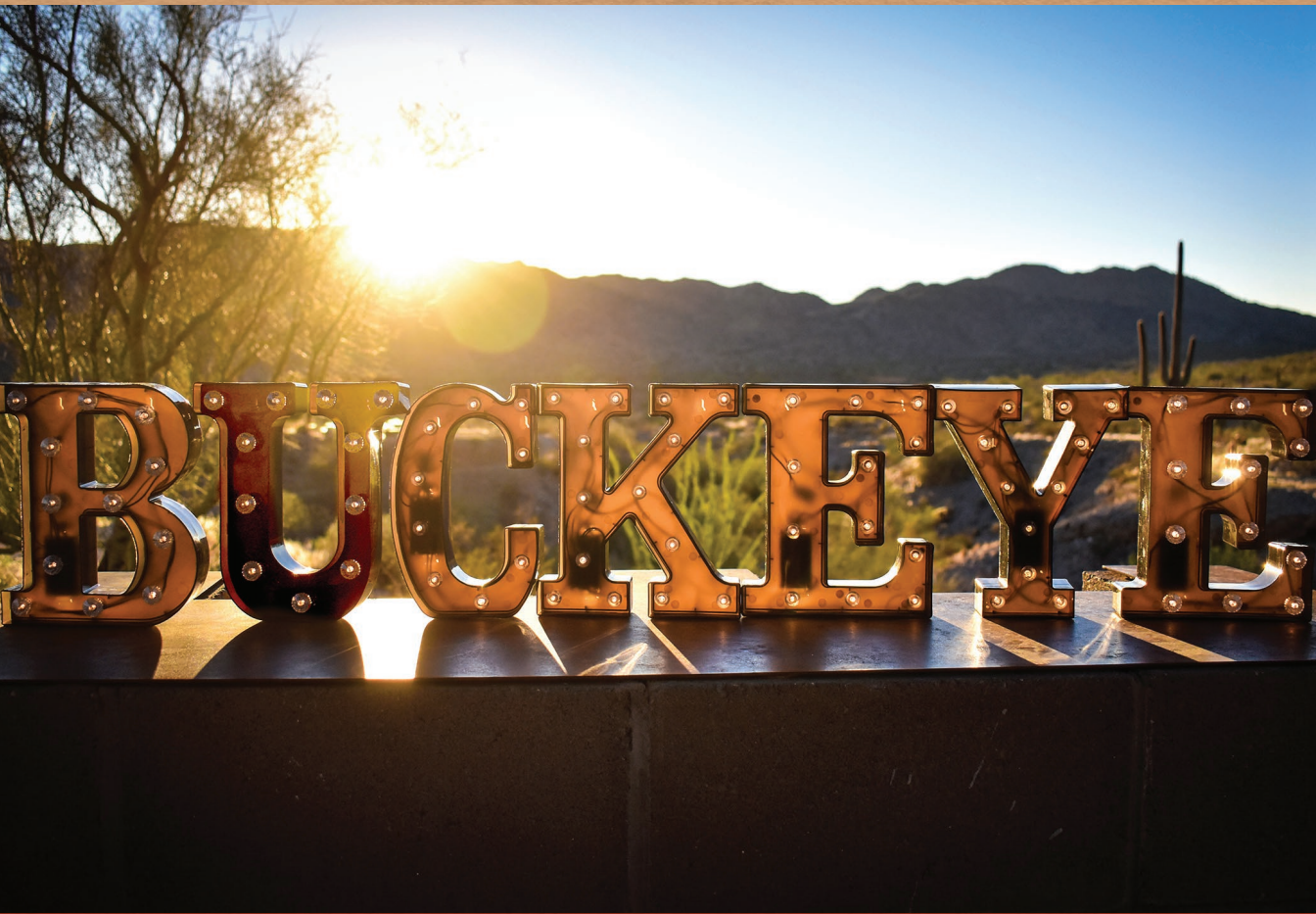
