Slow Cooker Chicken Wings

Ingredients

4 lbs. chicken wings, fresh or frozen

Buffalo Wing Sauce

- 1 1/2 cups Buffalo sauce, plus additional for finishing
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 onion, diced
- 4 cloves garlic, minced

For Serving

- Carrot sticks
- Celery Sticks
- Ranch dressing/ dip
- Chives for garnish

Instructions

- 1. Combine Buffalo Wing sauce ingredients and set aside.
- 2. Place wings in a 6 qt. slow cooker and cover with Buffalo wing sauce. Stir to combine.
- 3. Cook on high for 2.5-3 hours for FROZEN wings or on low 3 hours for FRESH wings.
- 4. Once cooked and wings have reached 165*, remove from the slow cooker and place on a foil lined pan (discard liquid).
- 5. Preheat broiler to high. Brush with additional Buffalo sauce and broil until lightly browned/crisp, about 5 minutes per side.
