## Bulk Trash 2022



City of Buckeye residents receive quarterly Bulk Trash disposal for items that are too big for the trash cart. New this year, bulky trash must be placed before the scheduled start to the collection week. Collection of your area may take multiple days to complete.

If you have concerns regarding collection, please post questions on the [Report a Concern](#) form.

To ensure your bulky trash is collected:

- Please place bulky trash out by Sunday night for [your collection week](#).
- Bulky trash piles may be as large as 6-feet wide, and 6-feet long. If you have more than this, please plan a visit to our [landfill](#).
- Cut and tie tree branches and large vegetation to 3-ft long bundles, and please box thorny branches.
- Always bag small items - Bulky trash is for items that do not fit in the trash can.

Remember, collection may occur later in the week, with one pick-up per household. Please see the collection schedule [here](#).
