Thanksgiving Service Interruption



In observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, all city offices will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 24.

There will be no trash or recycling collection on Thanksgiving Day. Thursday's service will move to Friday, and Friday's service moves to Saturday.

Please have your container out the night before your collection day.

Here are a few reminders while preparing for the Thanksgiving holiday:

- Never pour grease down the drain since it can clog sewer lines
- You can drop off used cooking oil as [household hazardous waste](#)

Household Hazardous Waste

Providing safe disposal of large amounts of cooking oil, paints, automotive fluids and potentially dangerous household items is an important part of safe trash collection. Residents may schedule a drop off of household hazardous materials by completing a form

at [buckeyeaz.gov/HHW](#). Public Works staff will call you to set the time and date.

This includes: pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, used cooking oil, auto fluids, paint, batteries, pool chemicals, cleaners, and more.

For safe storage, all materials must be in sealed containers.
