RESOLUTION NO. 126-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, ADOPTING A NOTICE OF INTENT TO ESTABLISH OR INCREASE BUCKEYE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT FEES AND TO MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC A WRITTEN REPORT IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED NEW OR INCREASED BUCKEYE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT FEES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Buckeye, Arizona (the "City Council"), may establish or increase fees within the City where (i) a schedule of the proposed new or increased fees that includes the amount of the proposed new or increased fees has been prepared, (ii) a written report or data supporting the new or increased fees has been prepared and made available to the public, (iii) a notice of intent to establish new or increased fees has been adopted, and (iv) the schedule of the proposed new or increased fees and the written report or data in support thereof was posted on the home page of the City's website at least 60 days before the date the proposed new or increased fees were approved or disapproved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a schedule setting forth the amount of the proposed new or increased Buckeye Municipal Airport fees and prepared a written report in support thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to declare its intention to establish or increase Buckeye Municipal Airport fees as described above and to post and distribute supporting documents pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15; and

WHEREAS, the Council may move to adopt the proposed new or increased Airport Fees, at its regular meeting to be held on February 7, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKEYE, ARIZONA, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That a Notice of Intent to establish or increase Buckeye Municipal Airport fees is hereby adopted in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as <u>Exhibit A</u>.
- Section 2. That the proposed new or increased Buckeye Municipal Airport fees will be considered by the City Council on February 7, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 530 East Monroe Avenue, Buckeye, Arizona.
- Section 3. That the written report in support of the proposed new or increased Buckeye Municipal Airport fees will be available to the public beginning December 7, 2023, in the office of the City Clerk, 530 East Monroe Avenue, Buckeye, Arizona, and on the home page of the City's website, and will be distributed through the City's social media accounts or other electronic communication tools.

Section 4. That a Notice of Intent in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as **Exhibit A** will be posted on the home page of the City's website and distributed through the City's social media or other electronic communication tools no later than December 7, 2023.

<u>Section 5</u>. That the Mayor, the City Manager, the City Clerk, and the City Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents and take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
