Let's Talk Trash!

(and Recycling too)



For your family's safety and the safety of our drivers, it's important all Buckeye residents follow these tips to ensure your trash and recycling service is not disrupted.

Can Placement

Street Collection

- Remember to place your trash and recycling carts in front of your house, on the street, the night before your collection day
- If you do not have an alley, place the carts with the wheels next to the curb or the edge of the street

Alley Collection

- If you have an alley, please place the cart on the right side of one-way alleys
- Please do not place carts on dead-end alleys, instead move to through-ways
- Container lids should open to the alley

In-Ground cans

- Let authorized staff pull and return the cans.
- Residents own and maintain the containers and surrounding structures

Remember to follow your HOA rules and remove the cans from the street no later than 11 p.m.



Trash & Recycle Collection Schedule



Trash Tips

- Please bag and tie all your trash
- Lids must be closed to receive service
- Bags placed on the street, next to the can, will not be picked up*
- Keep at least 10-feet between the can and your mailbox, trees, etc.

Household Hazardous Waste

Please store your household paints, pesticides, herbicides, pool chemicals, etc. for one of the city's scheduled Household Hazardous Waste collection events or schedule an appointment at buckeyeaz.gov/HHW

Recycling Tips

- Place items in the can loosely, without bagging*
- Items should be clean, dry and empty
- Break down large cardboard boxes
- Please do not recycle small items
- Plastic bags, yard waste, paper towels and napkins belong in the trash bin

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

All Buckeye residents may schedule to drop off approved HHW items at our Public Works Yard located at 23454 West MC 85, Buckeye. Complete a form at www.buckeyeaz.gov/HHW and we will call you.

*Current solid waste account required. No commercial waste accepted.



APPROVED ITEMS:

Pesticides, Herbicides, Fertilizers, Pool Chemicals, Paints, Cleaners, Automotive fluids (up to 5 gallons, check with your local auto shop first).

All material must be in a sealed container

Electronics: ONLY items with an integrated battery.

Southwest Regional Landfill

The Southwest Regional Landfill is owned by the Buckeye Pollution Control Corporation and operated by Republic Services. Located in the southernmost part of Buckeye, 10 miles South of the Gila River, on the East side of the SR 85.

City of Buckeye trash customers pay a reduced rate for the first 600 lbs. A copy of your current utility bill with a paid trash account is required.

Collection Week Schedule

Residents are required to have a solid waste account to use this service

Follow these tips to ensure your bulk trash piles are picked up as scheduled.

- Place bulk trash out by the Sunday night before your collection week begins
- Start piles as early as the weekend before your collection week
- Collection may occur later in week
- Piles of bulk trash should be approximately 6-feet wide, by 6-feet long, by 6-feet high
- Cut and tie tree limbs, branches and other large vegetation to 3-ft long bundles; box thorny branches
- Place your items at the front edge of your property
- Alley homes with no street front should place their pile at the end of the alley, in the HOA green space next to the street
