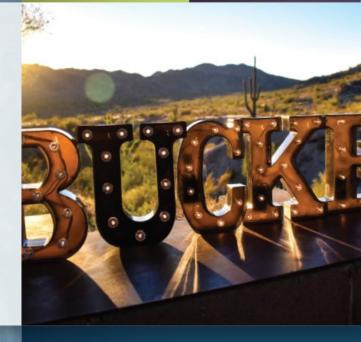

Adoption of Tentative Budget

- Sets the maximum expenditure limit
 Final Budget may be reduced but cannot be increased
- Sets 6/4 Special meeting to approve Final Budget and public hearing on TNT
- Sets 6/18 date for consideration to approve tax levy

Key Budgeting Practices

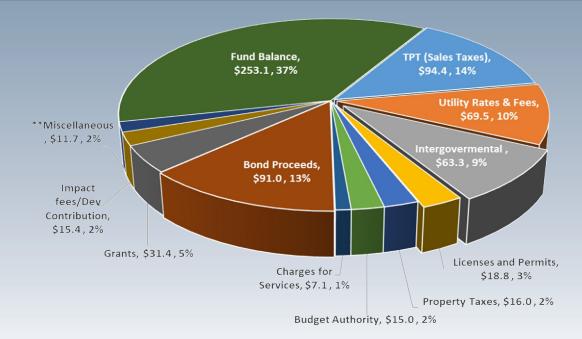
- Conservative revenue estimates
- Balanced budget
 - Ongoing expenses are paid with ongoing revenues
 - One-time revenues and fund balance are used to fund one-time expenditures
- Fully Funded 5-year CIP General Government
- Maintains 25% reserve for General Fund, Water and Wastewater
 - Modifies additional contingency requirement in General Fund
- Maintains maximum primary property tax levy
 - Tax rate for FY2025 is \$1.60 (reduction from FY2024 rate of \$1.65)

Where Does the Money Come From? - \$686.7 Million

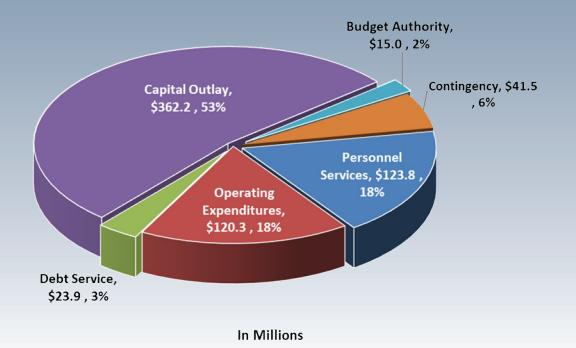

FY 2024-25 Expenditures Overview – All Categories

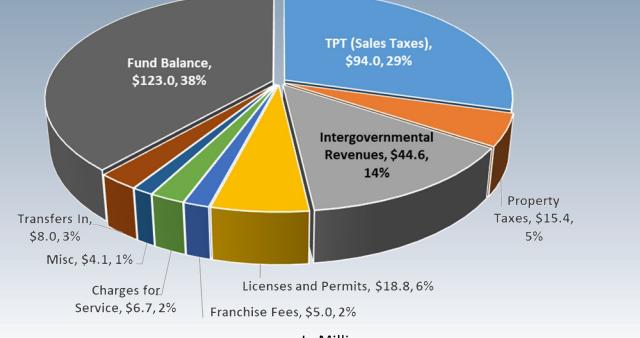
Where Does the Money Go? - \$686.7 Million

Where Does the Money Come From? - \$319.7 Million

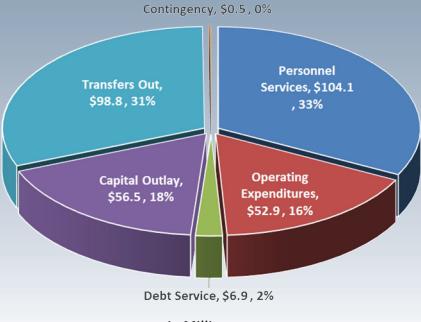

Where Does the Money Go? - \$319.7 Million

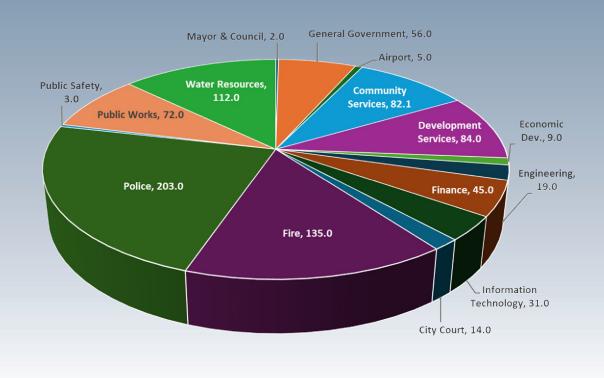

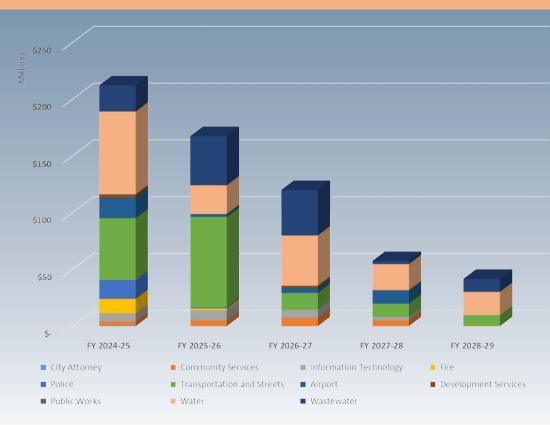


- 3.2% COLA effective PP beginning July 7th (July 26th paycheck)
