Here are the rules for submission for A Walk Down Memory Lane:

A Walk Down Memory Lane asks Arizona residents to submit an art piece they made during their childhood, 18 or younger, or made recently in the spirit of youth. We've all been young, and we've all made art, why not celebrate it?

- The art made during one's childhood will be entered for a potential prize. Those
 who submit art made in adulthood will not be entered for a prize but are highly
 encouraged to still showcase their work.
- Art will be judged in the following three categories: Creativity, Use of Color and Wow! Factor.
- Artwork must be an original work created by the participant. It should be made by hand without the use of AI or digital image generation.
- Original digital artwork is allowed, but it must be the sole and full creation of the participant.
- All pieces of 2D art must weigh no more than 2 pounds, including the frame. A standard carton of milk, full, is 2 pounds. Unframed art is preferred.
- All pieces of 3D art must weigh under 10 pounds and fit on top of the seat of a normal-sized chair.
- All pieces of art must not shed any substance through normal handling.
- All pieces MUST be accompanied by a filled-in Entry Form and a Waiver.
 - While we will make every effort to ensure no harm comes to any piece, such a possibility does exist. Entry forms must be filled out by someone 14 years old or older (it can be for a younger person). Waivers must be signed by an adult.
- Partners and groups may submit a piece. Please choose a representative of the group to fill out the information themselves. If a group wins a prize, only one prize will be given.
- City of Buckeye employees and their immediate families may show their work but will not be entered for a prize.
