Commercial Patio Cover or Ramada Checklist

Patio Cover or Ramada Definition and Uses

One story structures not exceeding 12 feet in height open on two sides or more detached from or attached to the existing building or freestanding on property not attached. Patio covers or Ramadas shall be used only for recreational, outdoor living purposes and not as carports, garages, storage rooms or habitable rooms.
